There is currently £14,290 remaining in the Council Grants budget.

Council to consider the following grant requests:

- Abertillery Town Cricket Club - £2,500 to establish and grow a sustainable women's cricket section. (Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, s.19).
- Zion Miners Chapel - £2221 to install a new toilet, fit new flooring in the kitchen and purchase a new cooker for the community room. (Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, s.19).
- Abertillery Royal British Legion - £700 to purchase a memorial stone and fund an unveiling event for Ted Gill. (The Local Authorities Cemeteries Order 1977 article 10 (1)(c)).

6. Annual Return (papers attached)

To note the RFO report and approve and sign the 2025/26 annual return.

7. Financial Regulations (papers attached)

Although the updated Financial Regulations were approved at the Full Council meeting on 20 May 2026, the resolution was not minuted, meaning they have to be approved again.

8. Insurance Renewal (papers attached)

To agree the renewal of the Zurich insurance policy priced at £1255.04 (This includes increased fidelity cover to £1,000,000 which is the level of cover recommended by the RFO). This is an increase in premium of £64.40. (There will be an additional increase in premium if Council decides to hire out the equipment from Frindiau Tyleri (tbc).

9. Chamber Microphone System (papers attached)

Council to decide what to do about the faulty chamber microphone system.

Option 1: Hire an electrician to investigate the issue and possibly repair.

Option 2: Replace the existing chamber microphone system with an identical one at a purchase price of £4280 (exc. VAT & fitting costs).

10. Ffrindiau Tyleri Funds

Ffrindiau Tyleri have transferred £3548.98 into the Council's bank account and transferred their material assets to Abertillery and Llanhilleth Community Council. Council need to decide what to do with the money. Two possible options could be:-

1. £3548.98 – move the money to Ear Marked Reserves and allocate to a budget line in 2027/28 to reduce the amount of precept?
2. Assets – Does Council want to hire out the assets (gazebos, tables etc) for community groups to use? (a policy would need to be drawn up and agreed by Council before this could happen).
