What are the aims of your project?

To raise funds to buy new equipment to further develop the club and our 115 members (all of whom are children). Some of our equipment is over 10 years old and no longer function effectively and therefore cannot be used. New equipment would allow the club to maximise the potential of our members and their development. We have recently purchased a new diving block to help both children and coaches during training sessions. Our new goal is to replace our competition racing lane ropes as our current set are brittle and sharp plastic fragments break off them every time we use them. As a result, the pool must be 'swept' to remove any broken pieces to prevent harm to swimmers.

How does your project benefit the Abertillery and Llanhilleth area or its residents?

We are a small community-based swimming club run entirely by volunteers from the local community. We have 115 members currently and more on our waiting lists ready to join. We have 5 volunteer coaches and 6 further volunteers who give up their free time to help the club run our 17 weekly classes and keep the club running smoothly. Our aim is to encourage children between 3

and 18 years old to learn an important skill that, not only gives them a regular form of exercise but also, gives the children an opportunity to have fun as they learn a skill that could one day save their lives. The club also allows children to mix and socialise with other children outside of school that they may otherwise not do. Should children wish to at an older age and ability level, they can take part in swimming competitions giving them opportunities to take up the sport at a competitive level. Throughout the year volunteers attempt to raise money to put on events for the children so their experiences at the club are made up of happy, lasting memories and in doing so we hope to encourage more children from the local community to join our little club.

What are the aims of your project? To support those with limited access to Christmas food and items to enjoy a Christmas.

Each household that is delivered to, receives food that includes a chicken, bacon sausage, butter, cheese, fruit and veg and cupboard items plus a few luxuries like cake, mince pies and chocolate to lift spirits!

Each food hamper is valued at approx. £68.00 plus!

How does your project benefit the Abertillery and Llanhilleth area or its residents?

Throughout the year we work with the Abertillery based Foodbank, by supporting each others enquiries when out of the immediate area, we recognise how our collaboration is a benefit to each area.

However the Christmas Hamper project is a stand alone project that focuses on this stressful season for many! For this project we work with partners such as Social Services: Flying start, Families First, Pobl, Platform, Cyfannol, C4W and others including some schools who know the families who are not in touch with the

'services' but who are very much in need. Local knowledge by some church ministers, town and borough councillors etc has also previously allowed us to help those who can be directed to also *self-refer.

The project helps those in your community council area by providing the food that they may otherwise not have access to over the Christmas period, this has been run for 3 years previously and in 2022, more than 80 households were supported within the Abertillery and Llanhilleth community council area – this year we anticipate it will be in excess of 100+ households being supported again just in this area.

We already have indications of 400 Christmas hampers being required, but we expect the number to be much higher!
